Physical Distancing

- Reduced to three feet in the classroom between students subject to certain requirements
 - Ventilation
 - Student cohorts/groups
 - Rate of community transmission
- Six feet maintained
 - Between adults and students (with exceptions)
 - When masks are removed; eating, drinking, masks breaks, etc.
 - Common areas
 - Physical education
- Classroom arrangement
 - Classrooms have been rearranged to three feet physical distancing

Transportation

- Masks use continues
- Family seating continues
- Cohort seating continues
- Increase in students on the bus
 - Splitting the local bus routes
 - Each route will require two runs in morning and afternoon
 - Second run in morning will result in students being picked up approximately 10 – 15 minutes later....these students live closest to the school

- Afternoon Transportation
 - Students who live farthest from school will be on first run, this is the majority of our students
 - Second run in the afternoon will result in students arriving home approximately 30 minutes later.....these are students who live closest to school
 - Students on the second bus run will wait in the gym

 - **Stanbro Road and Academy Road**
- **Jona – Bus 87**
 - **Beaver Creek Road, The Lane and Bliven Road**
- **Alan – Bus 81**
 - **Main Street and Fairground Road**

Food Service

- Meals will be served the classroom and the gym in order to maintain physical distancing
