

Transcript of January 13, 2021 announcement

This morning school personnel met with representatives from the Oneida County Department of Health and the Madison County Department of Health. The information they provided was considered along with other factors in determining if in-person instruction should resume next week.

Madison County Department of Health reported that county wide the number of COVID related cases is trending downward. That is very good news.

Unfortunately, that is not the case for our school district. Hopefully, we will reverse this trend soon and like Madison County experience fewer COVID related cases. Until that time we will remain on remote instruction. We anticipate evaluating this decision again on Thursday, January 21.

Please remember school is closed on Monday, January 18 in recognition of Martin Luther King Jr. Day. No instruction will occur on this holiday.
